RESULTS

The total sample contain 21(17.3%) have high online learning satisfaction group, 83 (69.2%) have average online learning satisfaction group and 16 (13.3%) of students have low online learning satisfaction group. Hence it was revealed that most of the students have average level of online satisfaction group.
